For larger tanker loads of product our terms are NET 10 days from invoice date. On all accounts a finance charge of 1.5% per month is added on all invoices not paid within terms. There is a minimum finance charge of \$.50.

If your account exceeds its credit limit at any time or falls in 60+ days past due it is subject to be shut off, without notice. The balance on the account will have to be paid in full before any additional credit is extended. Please notify us immediately if you cannot pay your bill on time.

Accounts may be paid by check, cash, credit card, or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). All accounts paid with credit card are subject to 3.5% processing fee, which is not greater than the cost of acceptance we incur in processing the transaction. All tanker load accounts will pay by EFT. If at anytime a check or EFT is denied for Non-Sufficient Funds (NFS) a Cashier Check will be required upon future deliveries until a certified letter is received by your bank verifying a sufficient line of credit.

This agreement and all transactions performed thereunder shall be governed by the laws of the State of Idaho.
